

In addition to the dramatic impact of these cuts, rates for public services keep increasing (tax, public daycares and health care, Hydro-Québec bills), the pension funds of municipal employees are being attacked (adoption of Bill 3), and we've seen that cutbacks and a major reorganization in health and social services (Bill 10) are threatening essential services.

## We say no to these attacks! If we are attacked, we must fight back and defend ourselves!

In the past months, not a week has gone by without demonstrations and other actions to oppose these ideological and financial choices.
